Summary

Moorfields has an established programme of annual core clinical outcome collection and presentation for all areas of ophthalmology. The core outcomes are widely accepted to be those which are most relevant for each sub-specialty. They are continuously updated as new areas of practice develop. We have achieved the gold standard for every metric for the last 3 years. Our aim is to make these outcomes representative of all patients treated at all Moorfields sites every 12 months. This is only possible by electronic automation, which is increasingly being used and by culture change, which we are seeing. This programme is improving quality of care and safety for patients at Moorfields and is improving practice worldwide, including the creation of a core clinical outcome dataset, which allows benchmarking of leading eye hospitals.
